

Ubiquity Lake Outfitters – Lake Trout Lures

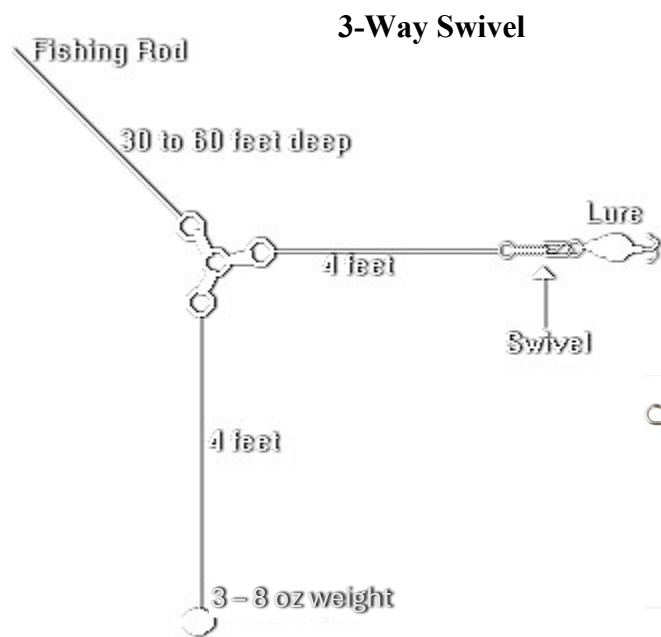
In early June most trolling methods that work for Northern Pike will also work well for Lake Trout. Troll using medium or deep diving crank baits or use 2 - 4 inch spoons in yellow, silver or a silver combo at least 1 oz in weight.

Summertime brings warm water and the trout go deeper. A quality 6'6" or 7' medium heavy action rod combined with your favorite reel that will hold 150 yards of 17+ pound test line will work well. Many fishermen use the same equipment for Lake Trout as they do for Pike.

Troll using 20' - 30' deep diving crank baits; look at Manns Baits, Rapala, Excalibur or Storm.

Lake Trout like bright colored lures. Lure colors that work well are white, bright greens, blues, yellows and oranges, silver, gold and combinations of silver/gold and silver/blue. The brighter the lure the better for Lake Trout. Size 50 & 60 flat fish and big spoons 4 - 6", such as Eppinger, Williams and Lucky Strike work well. Favourites of ours are the Gibbs Ruby Eye Wiggler (N) or the Lucky Strike Canoe shown below (#36).

One of the best combinations for Lake Trout in mid summer is using a quality 3-way swivel with a weight and a flashy silver spoon. A Pink Lady or a Dipsy Diver can also be used to get your lure down deep. The illustration below shows how to set it up your swivel:



We prefer to use 20lb test with this rig. A heavy action rod is a must. Tie two 4-foot pieces of line to your three-way swivel. Use a 3 - 8 oz. weight on one line and a light lure on the other.

Pink Lady

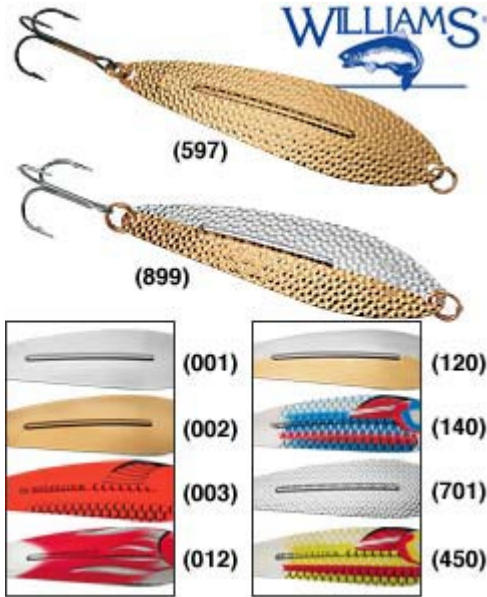


Vertical jigging with a big 2 oz. jig in white, orange or yellow can also work well. Fish the deep water humps with rocky bottoms and the boulder strewn flats. Summer trout will also be in the deep holes either between islands or in the main body of the lake. Try fishing slots where the big trout lie along the steep sides. If you've got a small portable downrigger, bring it along and use a Sutton spoon, Doctor spoon or a Red Eye to entice the trout.

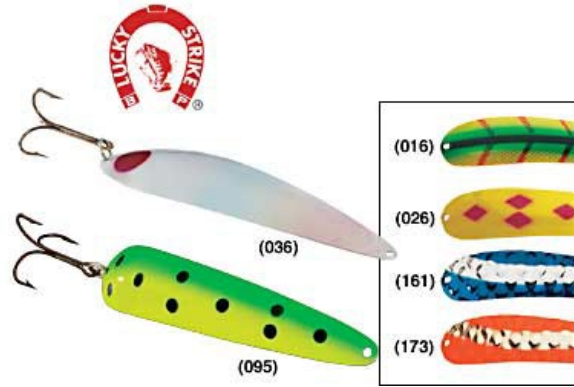

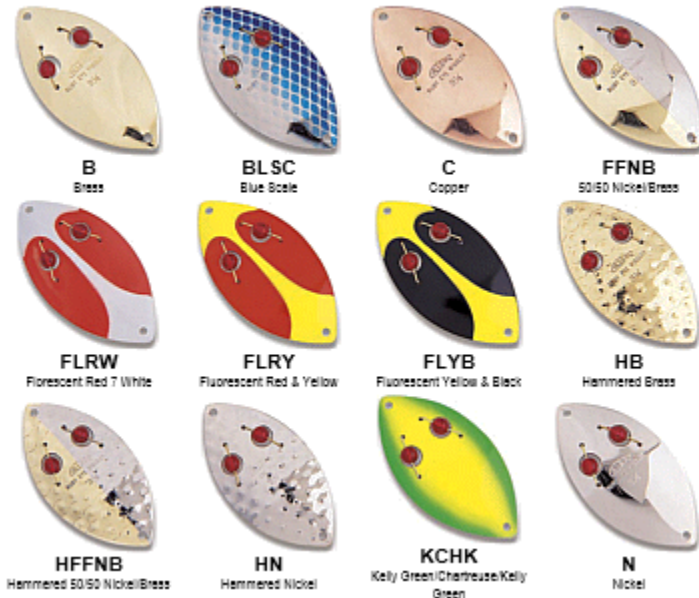
